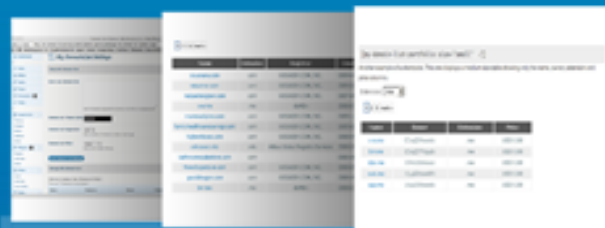

ABOUT

The My Domain List Plugin for WordPress allows domain owners to manage and promote their inventory of domains for sale. If you are not interested in selling your domains, My Domain List plugin also helps you manage your list of inventory keeping track of expiration dates and domain registrars.

The plugin enables admins to set domains for sale, set prices, and collect latest WHOIS information on the domains. The plugin has an admin interface that allows for configuration such as adding, deleting and updating domain information as well as setting plugin theme color, pagination, and filtering.

Simply enable the plugin in your post by using short code.

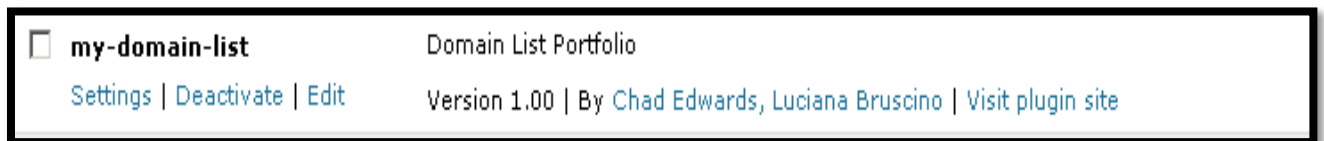

PLUGIN INSTALLATION

1. [Download the zip](#) file and extract the contents.
2. Upload the 'my-domain-list' folder to your plugins directory (wp-content/plugins/)
3. Activate the plugin through the 'plugins' page in WP Plugin page.

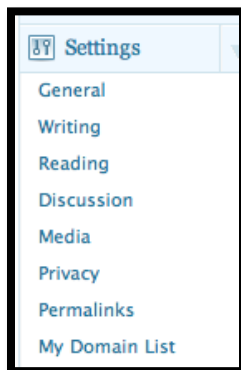
Once your plugin is activated, you should see the following on your Plugin's Page.

ADMIN PANEL

Once the plugin is activated, go to the Settings page. You will need to configure your My Domain List plugin to display the domain list, and set up page options. The Admin panel is divided into two parts: Setup Domain List and Manage Domain List.

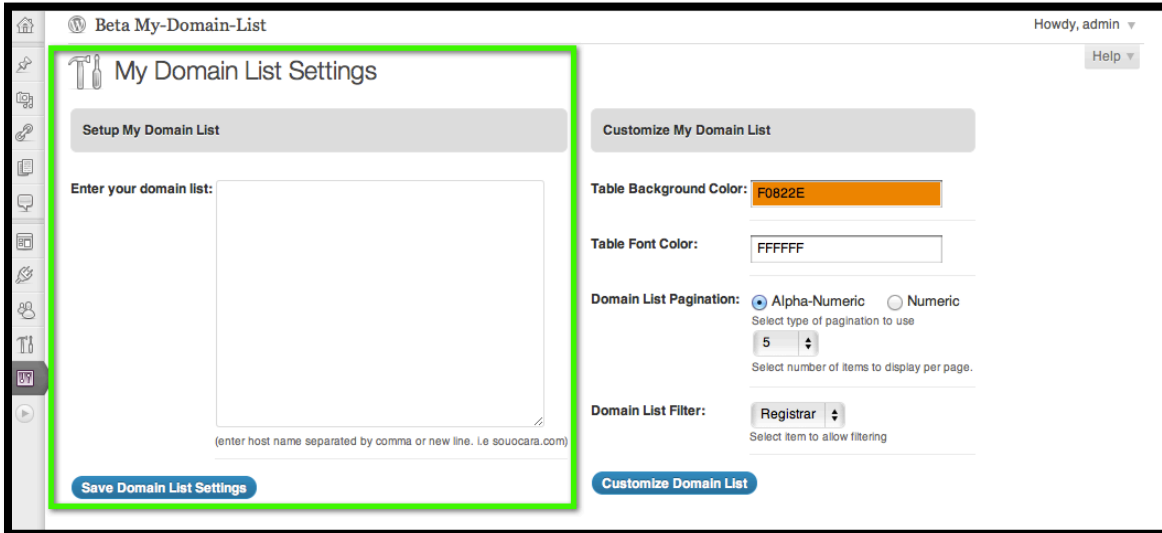


ADDING DOMAINS

Type your domain names with extension into the **Enter your domain list:**
You can enter multiple domain names by using a comma, a space or a new line.

Ex: brr.me, hyp.tel, my-domain-list.com

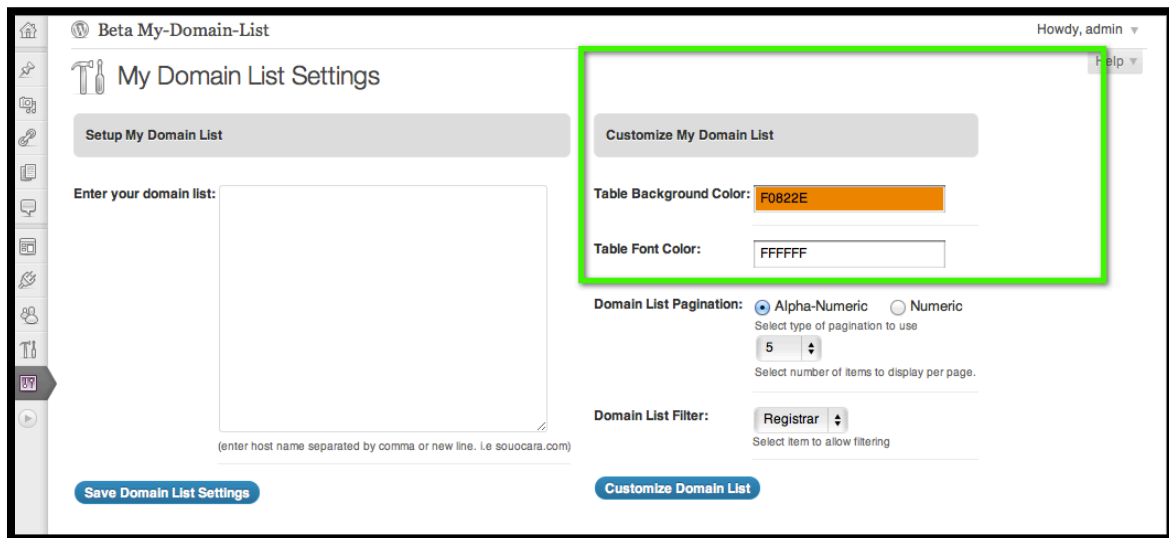
After entering all of your domains that you wish to add simply click on **the Save Domain List Settings** button. My-domain-list plugin will then save the data to your wordpress site along with who-is expiration and creation dates automatically.

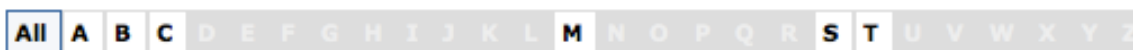
CHANGING DOMAIN TABLE HEADER COLORS

Using the color Selector in the **Domain List Theme Color** you can choose an array of colors, which will be presented on the Table header when displaying your domains to the public. There are options to change the header background color as well as the font color. *The default color is black background and white font.*



PAGINATION

Domain List Letter Pagination: – if you wish to display your domain names in pages by letter select the ABC radio button *The default value is All.*



Domain List Number Pagination: – if you wish to display your domain names in pages, please select the number of domains to display in each page. If you do not wish you to use pagination, select 'All'. *The default value is All.*




LIST FILTER

Domain List Filter - if you wish to allow your customers to filter your domain list based on extension, owner or registrar, use the domain-filtering feature available. This feature will create a dropdown box based on the option selected, in which the user can filter the domain name list. If you do not wish to turn on this feature, select None as the filter option.

MANAGING YOUR DOMAIN LIST

The Admin panel also allows you to **manage your domain list**. You can execute the following actions:

SET INDIVIDUAL DOMAIN PRICE

Input the **Sale price**, which will be displayed, on your list to public view.

GET UPDATED WHO-IS INFORMATION ON INDIVIDUAL DOMAIN

To get the most recent who-is information on individual domains, checkmark the **Get info** checkbox and then click on the **Refresh & Update Data** button

(Hover over the “i” to display the date when the domain was last updated)

DELETE INDIVIDUAL DOMAIN AS WELL AS REMOVE ALL FROM LIST

Checkmark the **Del Site** and then click on **Refresh & Update Data** button to delete an individual domain name. *If you delete the domain all data about the domain will be permanently removed from the database tables, including all offers made on that domain.*

KEEP DOMAINS PRIVATE (NOT LISTED)

Click on the **Unpublished** check box if you wish to not display the domain in your public view.

VIEW OFFER COUNT

The green dot indicates the number of offers made on that domain.

EXPIRATION OF REMINDER

The yellow (red, pink) dot indicates your domain is about to expire. Mouse-over dot for more information

DASHBOARD PANEL

My Domain List plugin provides the admin the ability to manage the offers made on each domain listed for sale. When the user makes an offer on the domain through the make offer button, an entry will be created on the dashboard as displayed below

VIEWING OFFERS

The offers are grouped by domain. In order view the offers made, click on the domain and you will see the date and offer amount displayed underneath.

REPLY

It allows you to communicate via direct email with the person who made the offer.

VIEW COMMENT

It allows you to view the comments made by the person who made the offer

DELETE

It allows you to delete the offer made. *The offer will be permanently deleted*

SHORTCODE

My-Domain-List Plugin utilize Wordpress shortcode to display your domain lists in posts or pages. The plugin can be use customized attributes or in its default form.

DEFAULT SHORTCODE

In order to display the My Domain List plugin on your post, you will use a variation of the shortcode below. *Default will display all supported columns in a large table size layout*

Example:

```
[my-domain-list-portfolio/]
```

CUSTOMIZED SHORTCODE

TABLE SIZE

The **size** attribute the table size that is displayed to the user in the post or page.

Valid values: small, medium, large

Default value is: large

Example:

```
[my-domain-list-portfolio size='medium']
```

TABLE COLUMNS

The **show** attribute specifies the columns to be displayed on the domain list table.

Valid Values: owner, extension, registrar, created, changed, expires, price, offer

Default is show all columns

Example:

```
[my-domain-list-portfolio show='owner,extension,registrar']
```

DOMAIN LIST TABLE

This is the public facing domain list that your users will see. This table can be customized based on your shortcode.

MAKE AN OFFER

When **make offer** button is clicked the make offer form (shown on the right) will appear as a modal.

When **make an offer** button is clicked the offer can be viewed on the dashboard.

CURRENCY

The user has the ability to switch among the different currencies. Values: USD, EUR, and GBR
